## Ordnance Survey Plans

### Planning Applications

Please refer to the relevant [Planning Application Form Guidance](#) for detailed information on the plans required.

For most applications, an Ordnance Survey-based Location Plan (1:2500) and Site Plan (1:500) will be required.

The plan must:

- show the direction North;
- detail the development site outlined in red;
- show land under the applicant's control outlined in blue; and
- must accurately depict the surrounding land features and any buildings.

You can buy Ordnance Survey plans from an official Ordnance Survey agent or retailer. A list of online [partners](#) of Ordnance Survey can be found via the following link:
