Parental Employability Support Fund

PESF ensures as many parents as possible, including those further from labour market and facing complex or challenging circumstances, will have the opportunity to access fair and sustainable work.

Working alongside the local authority, businesses and third sector, we will support parents in the local community to progress through training and/or qualifications, working toward employment and increased income. PESF ensures there is the right support in place to help the family groups by providing parents with additional support to participate and progress throughout the labour market.

Who is this supporting and how?

- Person-centred help for parents to address barriers to work, increasing skills and work experience. Health support, money advice and motivational support are also offered.
- Targeted support to help parents already in jobs support through the provision of training and employability support to remain active in the workplace and gain progression through a rewarding career.

What is Parental Employability Support Fund and how will it work?

- ♣ PESF is a government funded program that will help unemployed or low income parents gain employment or increased wages
- Everyone participating will have an action plan and individuals will participate in a programme tailored to their own learning and employability
- The content of the action plan should include progression identifying a clear pathway to employment.

What do we aim to achieve

- Participant gains qualification or certification
- Participant gains employment or becomes self employed
- Participant continues with employment
