



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

COMHAIRLE NAN EILEAN SIAR

(A859 MARYBANK EXTENSION) (40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021

Comhairle nan Eilean Siar proposes to make the “Comhairle nan Eilean Siar (A859 Marybank Extension) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2021 under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any person from driving or causing or permitting to be driven, any vehicles on the A859 road from a point 80m south west of the access to the Lochside Arena, north eastwards to Marybank Quarry, at a speed exceeding 40mph. This is a length of 1.5km or thereby.

Full details of these proposals are in the Draft Order which, together with a map showing the length of the road affected and a statement of the Comhairle’s reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined on the Comhairle’s website at <https://www.cne-siar.gov.uk/troip/> .
