

## Museum & Tasglann nan Eilean Photograph Competition 2022 Inspired by Scotland's Photograph Album

### Eligibility

1.1 The photography competition is open to all.

### Entry

2.1 You can enter the competition by submitting your photograph in digital format by email to [museum@cne-siar.gov.uk](mailto:museum@cne-siar.gov.uk). With the subject heading "**Photography Competition Entry.**" No other method of entry will be accepted.

2.2 The closing date for all competition entries is 6pm, Thursday 30 June 2022. Any submissions received after this time will not be entered into the competition.

2.3 To enter the competition you need to have taken a photo within the Outer Hebrides between the current day and June 2020 – in the last 2 years!

2.4 Images can be of landscapes or of people or of architecture – we want to capture all aspects of life in the Outer Hebrides

2.5 Images can be in colour or in black and white.

2.6 Images submitted must not have been published elsewhere (excluding social media) or have won a prize in any other photographic competition or be entered into a major competition where the results are still pending.

2.7 All images (from both digital cameras and smartphones) must be high resolution and must be a JPEG file. Maximum file size is 10MB.

2.8 All photographs must be your own work, must not be copied or contain any third-party materials including trademarks or trade names and/or content that you do not have permission to use.

2.9 When submitting your photograph, you should attach the Competition entry form and provide your name, address, age, school (where applicable), email address and a brief sentence (maximum 70 words) explaining the inspiration/story behind the photo. We will only use your personal information in relation to the competition (including checking your eligibility to enter it) and will not use it for any other purposes whatsoever. We will not keep this information for longer than is necessary for the operation of the competition. If the photographer wishes to remain anonymous a request must be made to Museum & Tasglann nan Eilean when submitting their entry.

2.10 You may send a maximum of three entries to the competition.

2.11 The photograph must not contain defamatory, obscene or offensive material, not showcase connotations of violence, racism, discrimination, or be sexual in its nature.

2.12 The photograph must be suitable to be exhibited in Museum & Tasglann nan Eilean and on our website/ social media and be appropriate for all ages.

2.13 It is the responsibility of each entrant to ensure that any images they submit have been taken with the consent of anyone who is identifiable in that image or the consent of their parent/guardian if they are under 16 and that they have been advised of the purpose of the submission and that their photograph may be published. We may require them to sign a permission form if it is a winning entry.

2.13 The photographer may only enter individually and not as part of a team.

## Picking the winners

3.1 All entries that meet the competition criteria will be reviewed by the judges to create an exhibition of 30 photos.

3.2 All valid entries will be judged within three categories

- 5 – 11 year olds
- 12 – 18 year olds
- Adults

3.3 They will be judged on the theme: People, Landscape, Architecture, Community. We want the exhibition to capture all aspects of life in the Outer Hebrides!

3.4 The judges will be looking for:

- Originality and creativity
- Impact
- Composition and technical ability

3.5 There will be a selection of 30 winning photographs selected by the judges. The judge's decision will be made on or before 30 July 2022. The decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

## The winning entries

4.1 The winners will be notified by Museum & Tasglann nan Eilean via email the week commencing 15 August 2022.

4.2 The winning photos will be exhibited in Museum & Tasglann nan Eilean in 2022 and it is also hoped to display them online. The selected photos will create the **'Outer Hebrides 2022 Collection – inspired by the MacKinnon Collection'**.

## The Prize

5.1 The top 10 winners in each category will receive: inclusion of their photo in the exhibition in Museum & Tasglann nan Eilean.

5.2 The top 3 winners in each category will also win cash prizes as follows possible through the kind funding of the Art Fund, Scottish Government and Heritage Fund;

**5-11 year olds**

1st	£50
2nd	£40
3rd	£20

**12-18 year olds**

1st	£100
2nd	£50
3rd	£25

**Adult**

1st	£150
2nd	£75
3rd	£50

5.3 The school to which the 1<sup>st</sup> place winner in the 5-11 and 12-18 categories belong will also win a cash prize as follows;

5 – 11 year old's school	£100
12 – 18 year old's School	£100

5.4 The prizes cannot be exchanged or transferred by you and cannot be redeemed by you for any other prizes.

## Administration

6.1 All announcements in relation to the Museum & Tasglann nan Eilean photography competition will be published on the Museum & Tasglann nan Eilean website and social media pages.

6.2 The competition will be administered by the Museum & Tasglann nan Eilean Heritage Team. By entering the competition, the photographer consents to their name and their photo to be published on the Museum & Tasglann nan Eilean website, social media channels and other media. If the photographer wishes to remain anonymous a request must be made to Museum & Tasglann nan Eilean when submitting their entry.

6.3 We take no responsibility for entries that are lost, delayed, misdirected or incomplete or cannot be delivered or entered for any technical or other reason. Proof of delivery of the entry is not proof of receipt.

6.4 Museum & Tasglann nan Eilean will only process the personal data you have provided to administer the photography competition. Personal details will not be passed on to third parties.

6.5 These Terms and Conditions are available on our website. Should the terms and conditions be amended, these avenues will be updated for entrants review. If printed, this is not a controlled document.

6.7 The winning entrants grant Museum & Tasglann nan Eilean (as part of Comhairle nan Eilean Siar) all necessary and relevant licenses and permissions in relation to the publication of their entries in Museum & Tasglann nan Eilean publications (although the publishing of any entries in or on any of

Museum & Tasglann nan Eilean publications shall be at the absolute discretion of Museum & Tasglann nan Eilean. Museum & Tasglann nan Eilean shall be under no obligation to publish such entries) and elsewhere at Museum & Tasglann nan Eilean discretion. The winning photographers also agree to take part in any reasonable post-draw publicity required by Museum & Tasglann nan Eilean including use of the entry as outlined in clause 7.3 and 7.4.

6.8 Entrants will be deemed to have accepted these terms and conditions and to have agreed to be bound by them when entering the competition.

## Copyright and Usage

7.1 Entrants remain the copyright holder to any images submitted by themselves.

7.2 Winning entrants agree to grant Museum & Tasglann nan Eilean a nonexclusive irrevocable licence to reproduce, enlarge, publish and exhibit for any purpose related to the competition their image in any medium, including print and digital.

7.3 This includes, but is not restricted to; exhibiting, for use in press, and on websites and social media.

7.4 The entrants agree to Museum & Tasglann nan Eilean free usage sublicensing the shortlisted images for press articles or any other external communications related to the competition.

7.5 After the winners have been announced entries will be deleted, apart from those that have been selected.

7.6 Museum & Tasglann nan Eilean will try to ensure the photographers will be credited on all mediums. In the event of inadvertent omission of the credit, Museum & Tasglann nan Eilean will endeavour to correct where possible, but the photographer agrees that Museum & Tasglann nan Eilean are not to be liable.

7.7 The entrant is responsible for any claim made by a third party against the submission.

## Disclaimer
