Comhairle nan Eilean Siar proposes to make the Comhairle nan Eilean Siar (Off-Street) Parking Places (Pay & Display) Order 2017 under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to extend the pay & display parking areas within Stornoway town centre.

The changes are detailed below.

**South Beach St** – Parking area adjacent to the Caledonian Hotel.

50p for up to 1 hour

£1 for up to 8 hours

£1.50 for up to 24 hours

Maximum Stay 24 hours

No return within 2 hours

**South Beach St** – Parking area adjacent to the Star Inn

£1 for up to 1 hour

Maximum Stay 1 hour

No return within an hour

**Perceval Square Car Park (existing pay & display) and the Fisherman's Car Park**

50p for up to 1 hour

£1 for up to 2 hours

£1.50 for up to 3 hours

Maximum Stay 3 hours

No return within 2 hours
