



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

COMHAIRLE NAN EILEAN SIAR STORNOWAY TOWN CENTRE (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2008 (AMENDMENT NO 1) (BAYHEAD AND SCOTLAND STREET) ORDER 2013

Comhairle nan Eilean Siar proposes to make the following amendments to the *Comhairle nan Eilean Siar Stornoway, Town Centre (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2008* in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the amendments will be to add a waiting restriction at Bayhead and a one way system at Scotland Street to the regulations promoted in the original Order. The changes are summarised below:

1. Bayhead Street

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting for a period of more than 8 hours, return prohibited within 2 hours, within the lay-by on the west side (harbour side) of Bayhead Street from the harbour access opposite Kenneth Street to the Bridge Centre.

2. Scotland Street

The effect of the Order will be to make a section of the street, a one-way street operating in one direction from its junction with Kenneth Street towards its junction with Keith Street.

Full details of these proposals are in the Draft Order which, together with a map showing the length of the road affected and a statement of the Comhairle's reasons for proposing to make the Order are in the associated documentation on this section of the Comhairle's website.

Any person wishing to object to the proposed Order should send details of the grounds for objection in writing to the Chief Executive, Comhairle nan Eilean Siar, Sandwick Road, Stornoway, to be received by **Friday 29 March 2013**. Objections should state the name and address of the objector, matters to which they relate and the grounds on which they are made.
