



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

COMHAIRLE NAN EILEAN SIAR

(A858 GARYNAHINE, CALLANISH & BREASCLETE, ISLE OF LEWIS) (40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2017

[TRO-17/02]

Comhairle nan Eilean Siar proposes to make "The Comhairle nan Eilean Siar (A858 Garynahine, Callanish & Breasclete, Isle of Lewis) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2017 under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any person from driving or causing or permitting to be driven, any vehicles on:

- (i) the A858 road at Garynahine from the bus layby, east of the Uig junction, in a North Westerly direction through Garynahine village to a point 95m north west of the access to Tigh Melros an overall length of 1km or thereby at a speed exceeding 40mph.
- (ii) the A858 road at Callanish from a point 45m south of the fence line at the war memorial in a North and North Westerly direction through Callanish and Breasclete to a point 45m north of the cattle grid at the entrance to Breasclete, an overall length of 3.2km or thereby, at a speed exceeding 40mph.
- (iii) the side roads coming off the A858 in Callanish and Breasclete covering the Park Road Callanish, Breasclete Loop and the section of the Pentland Breasclete road between Breasclete Loop junction and Breasclete Pier at a speed exceeding 30mph.
