Scottish Ministers – Consultation with Comhairle nan Eilean Siar

An application for section 36 consent and deemed planning permission was submitted to the Energy Consents Unit in August 2023. The development is subject to Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA). An EIA Report has been produced by the Applicant to accompany the application for consent. Comhairle nan Eilean Siar was consulted on the EIA application on 06 September 2023.

Following initial consultation and assessment, additional information in the form of Supplementary Environmental Information (SEI) was requested under the Regulations.

The SEI was submitted to the Energy Consents Unit in June 2024, and Comhairle nan Eilean Siar was consulted on the SEI on 01 July 2024.
