.Crown Estate Fund has been awarded - £15,000.

All information for the startup fund has been sent to the CNES. Hold ups from cyber-attack have slowed the process down.

Councilors believe that match funding may be available with the Ward Fund.

Project planning and design can start following the award of £15,000.

Community Council will include the redevelopment of access at the Traigh Mhor within this grant – NTCC are owners of this gate.

TCDL have allowed NTCC to pay loan back when the NTCC financial can.

Sprayer course will be available in October. This will help eradicate the problems with Gunnera and other evasive species. NTCC actively encouraging volunteers to participate.
