<b>CalMac</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Lochboisdale port staff in attendance to give report on staff treatment during the recent ferry disruption</li> <li>- LBCC circulated notice from CalMac about staff treatment on social channels</li> <li>- Agreed that better comms from CalMac would improve situation for staff and customers</li> <li>- Options to reduce disruption impact in the future were discussed such as Lochboisdale getting the MV Clansman back and ferry going to Armadale instead of Mallaig</li> <li>- PFS said all of these options had been brought to CalMac before and been rejected but we could ask again</li> <li>- Lack of business case for new Lochboisdale pier was brought up and discussed</li> <li>- PFS said that the LOTI is the next boat due to be replaced</li> <li>- PS said that new pier situation looking more and more unlikely and expensive</li> <li>- Transport Scotland were originally to contribute 80% of cost of new pier but will now be 60%</li> <li>- Pier reaches end of life in 2030</li> <li>- Storas Uibhist and other Community Councils writing letters to CalMac and gov</li> </ul>	Draft letters to CalMac and gov - SS and KM to meet and discuss next steps	SS + KM	ASAP
