

Nicolson Institute Pupil Bursaries – Ross and Cromarty Educational Trusts

Criteria for successful candidates for Bursary 1:

- 1 Applicant must be attending the Nicolson Institute as an S4, S5 or S6 pupil to be eligible to apply for this Bursary;
- 2 Applicant must have resided in the Bernera Primary School catchment area;
- 3 The bursary pot of £330 is to be shared equally among all eligible applicants meeting criteria 1, 2 and 4;
- 4 Applicant must be eligible for receipt of an EMA while studying at the Nicolson Institute;
- 5 If no EMA pupils have resided in the Bernera area during their primary school years, then the funds will be distributed between all eligible pupils meeting criteria 1 and 2.

Criteria for successful candidates for Bursary 2:

1. Applicant must be attending the Nicolson Institute as an S4, S5 or S6 pupil to be eligible to apply for this Bursary;
2. Applicant must be resident in the Pairc School catchment area and have attended Pairc School;
3. The bursary pot of £530 is to be shared equally among all eligible applicants meeting criteria 1,2 and 4;
4. Applicant must be eligible for receipt of an EMA while studying at the Nicolson Institute;
5. If no EMA pupils have resided in the Pairc area during their primary school years, then the funds will be distributed between all eligible pupils meeting criteria 1 and 2.

Criteria for successful candidates for Bursary 3:

1. Applicant must be attending the Nicolson Institute as an S4, S5 or S6 pupil to be eligible to apply for this Bursary;
2. Applicant must reside in Balallan and have attended school in North Lochs;
3. The bursary pot of £800 is to be shared equally among all eligible applicants meeting criteria 1,2 and 4;
4. Applicant must be eligible for receipt of an EMA while studying at the Nicolson Institute;
5. If no EMA pupils have resided in the Pairc area during their primary school years, then the funds will be distributed between all eligible pupils meeting criteria 1 and 2.

Protocols and timescales for payment of bursary awards:

- 1 Successful applicants must have their residential and schooling status verified by SEEMIS before the issue of the relevant Bursary.
- 2 Once attendance at the Nicolson Institute has been confirmed at the start of the August term, the bursary award will be issued.
