### **CAPITAL STRATEGY 2023-28 UPDATE**

# **PURPOSE**

1.1 The purpose of the Report is to present to Members the updated Capital Strategy for 2023-28.

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

- 2.1 The Prudential Code underpins the system of capital finance in local authorities. The 2017 edition of the code introduced a requirement for authorities to have a Capital Strategy in place by the 2019/20 financial year.
- 2.2 The Capital Strategy is intended to give a high-level overview of how capital expenditure, capital financing and treasury management activity contribute to the provision of services, along with an overview of how associated risk is managed and the implications for future financial stability. This brings together the various strands of the capital investment process, such as the Treasury Management and Asset Management Strategies.
- 2.3 The Appendix to the Report sets out the Comhairle's Strategy for 2023-28, within the context of the 2023-28 Capital Programme, which will be updated annually.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

3.1 It is recommended that the Comhairle approve the Capital Strategy 2023-28 appended to the Report.
