- 2.1 In September 2023, the Committee agreed the membership of a Roads Investment Member Officer Working Group (MOWG) which would meet to consider future roads investment options based on available funding and any deterioration in condition.
- 2.2 The remit of the Roads Investment MOWG was to consider future roads investment options based on available funding and any deterioration in condition and to consider the operation of the Road Asset Management Policy, Road Asset Management Plan and the Winter Maintenance Policy.
- 2.3 There is a vacancy on the MOWG following the resignation of Councillor Grant Fulton. It has been the Comhairle's practice that the newly elected Member takes over the appointments of the previous Elected Member. The current membership of the MOWG is:
