Proposal of Application Notice: Proposed Construction and Operation of a Strategic Electricity Transmission Hub Consisting of a 400kV AC Substation, an HVDC Converter Station, and the Associated Undertaking of Earthworks, the Formation of Platforms, Landscaping, Means of Access, Means of Enclosure, Site Drainage, Temporary Construction Compounds, Peatland Reprofiling and Improvement and Other Associated Operations (National Development) at Land at, and in the vicinity of Macaulay Farm, Arnish Moor, Isle of Lewis, HS2 9JN

Scottish Hydro Electric Transmission plc (the Prospective Applicant), operating and known as Scottish and Southern Electricity Networks Transmission (SSEN Transmission), is pleased to submit this Proposal of Application Notice (PAN) and attached site outline drawing relating to the Construction and Operation of a Strategic Electricity Transmission Hub Consisting of a 400kV AC Substation, and an HVDC Converter Station, and the Associated Undertaking of Earthworks, the Formation of Platforms, Landscaping, Means of Access, Means of Enclosure, Site Drainage, Temporary Construction Compounds, Peatland Reprofiling and Improvement and Other Associated Operations (National Development) at Land at, and in the vicinity of Macaulay Farm, Arnish Moor, Isle of Lewis, HS2 9JN

The Prospective Applicant has planned two in-person public consultation events. The first will be held at Cabarfeidh Hotel, Perceval Road South, Stornoway, Isle of Lewis HS1 2EU on 05 September 2024 between 1500 and 1900 hours. The last public event will be held at the same venue on 14 November 2024 between 1500 and 1900 hours.

Statutory newspaper notices relevant to the public events will be placed in The Stornoway Gazette. The first event will be advertised on 22 August 2024 and the current aim is to advertise on or around 31 October 2024 but in any case, no less than seven days in advance of the final event.
